<u>Abstract</u>

Novartis Crop Protection is developing Adage[®], a new extremely efficacious seed treatment insecticide belonging to the chemical class known as neonicotinoide. Adage[®] at 300 gai/100Kg (7.65 fl.oz./cwt) of cottonseed has provided excellent aphid, and thrip control, similar to Temik[®] at 3.5 lbs/A applied in-furrow at planting. Adage[®] provided good control of the western flower thrip (*F. occidentalis*).

Adage[®], having a water solubility value of 4,100 ppm, has proven to be a key factor in the consistent performance over other neonicotinoides. Adage[®] has provided excellent Thrip and Aphid control and has out yielded the fungicide check by over 300 lbs lint cotton per acre in 2000 trials.
