Dear Secretary Vilsack:

As you develop your budget proposal for Fiscal Year 2011, we respectfully request that you maintain funding for the Market Access Program (MAP), which is critical to job-retention and creation in rural communities throughout the United States. By boosting access to overseas markets through consumer promotion, market research, and technical assistance, MAP benefits American farmers and the nation's economy, while improving our trade balance and creating jobs.

As you know, our nation's unemployment rate is at a 26-year high. We believe that full funding for MAP is essential to the agricultural-based economy of rural America. Agriculture-based communities are often the slowest to recover from economic downturns. Policies and programs that support our farmers and farm communities must be a part of getting our economy back on track.

MAP is directed at a wide variety of agriculture producers, and is especially important to those who do not receive subsidy payments. Not only must program participants generate significant nonfederal matching funds, but they must also provide detailed records of their expenses that are subject to audits. In addition, applications for MAP funds undergo a competitive review process and all program participants must demonstrate a high level of performance.

MAP is a proven and cost-effective program that is particularly important to the economy in rural communities and trade-dependent states. After numerous hearings in both the Agriculture and Foreign Affairs Committees, Congress authorized \$200 million a year for MAP in the latest Farm Bill. We encourage you to maintain the full amount in your budget proposal to Congress and look forward to working with you to support this program for American farmers and farm communities.
