We represent a variety of public and private sector organizations including agriculture and silviculture producer groups and suppliers, as well as non-agricultural users of pesticides. We believe that all Americans benefit from a regulatory system that is grounded in science, balances risks and benefits, and provides certainty that allows technology providers to continue investments in innovation to meet the need for modern pest control tools while also protecting human health and the environment.

Specifically, we would like to emphasize the importance of key issues contained within the House version of the Horticulture Title of the Farm Bill which relate to the registration and use of pesticides under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). It is our hope that during the conference process these important and much needed provisions will warrant consideration by conferees and will be included in the final conference report.

These reforms would increase the global competitiveness of American agriculture, encourage much needed innovation, and reduce costs to American farmers and ranchers and other users of pesticides who protect public health and our environment. We thank the Senate Agriculture Committee for their attention to these important matters, and we are committed to working with you to advance these imperative reforms.
