## ANNUAL REPORT OF THE JOURNAL OF COTTON SCIENCE

Sixty-nine manuscripts representing all nine disciplines were submitted in 2007. A summary of the action taken on these manuscripts by discipline is provided in Table 1. The acceptance rate for manuscripts for which a decision has been made is 53.3%.

In 2007, 34 manuscripts were published in the *Journal of Cotton Science*. Distribution of published

manuscripts by discipline is as follows: Agronomy and Soils – 6; Arthropod Management – 3; Breeding and Genetics – 5; Economics and Marketing – 2; Engineering and Ginning – 3; Molecular Biology and Physiology – 2; Plant Pathology and Nematology – 3; Textile Technology – 6; Weed Science – 2; and Editorial Notes - 2.
