

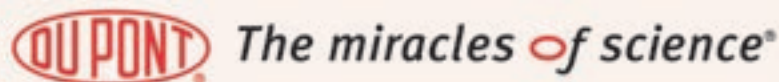
2002-2003 **Cotton Leadership Class**
